5. Club Permits:

5.1 The Club must maintain a Register of Vehicles on the Victorian Club Permit Scheme as specified by VicRoads.

5.2 Club Permits are to be available on to those who have been a member of the club for a **minimum of 3 months.**

5.2.1 The Committee will however consider applications under the 3 month period based only their merit. Such special applications may include, but not be limited to, such reasons as returning lapsed members or people moving from interstate.

5.3 Club Permits will only be approved for Rover vehicles.

5.3.1 The Committee will however consider applications for a non-Rover to be granted a Club Permit if the owner already has, and continues to have, at least one Rover on a Club Permit.
